From Your Editor

Hi Fellow Eagles,

There have been some problems reported at the field by flyers still using the old 72MHz band. In an effort to discover what was going on, my friend Dave who holds a first class FCC license and is also a former electronic technician and I brought his spectrum analyzer to the field. The analyzer showed some moderate interference on the lower end of the 72 MHz band @ covering channels 38 to 52. The noise seems to be data but could also be noise from a motor or other electrical source. The gist of the matter is that I would not recommend the use of 72 MHz radios at our field until we can find the source (which may not be possible). For the time being if you fly 72MHz at the field you do so with the understanding that there is a known risk. The 72MHz band is open to anyone for the remote control of objects including locomotives, cranes, and other industrial equipment. It also includes part of the TV broadcast band. I will keep you informed as the search goes on.

Fall is only a few days away so get all the flying in you can. It's going to be another long cold winter.

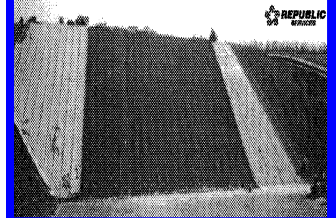
