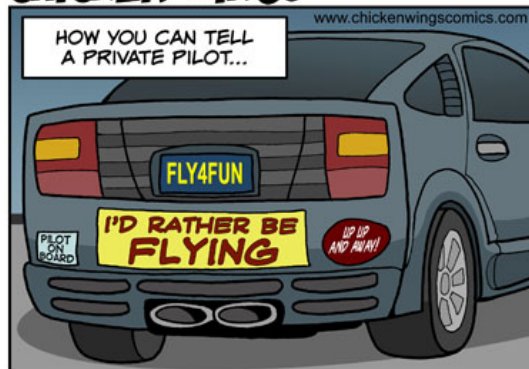
Jon Elsasser has a Drifter II 2 meter sailplane that he would like to pay to have built. Anyone interested in building the kit, please contact Jon at:
